Dear Parents/Guardians,

Welcome to a new term at Rivervale Primary School! We are excited to continue the next chapter of learning and growth with your child/ward for the year. In Term 1, we observed the following concerns.

1. Punctuality for School

We have observed an increasing number of Riverlites reporting late for school. We strongly encourage them to arrive at the assembly area by 7.25 am. This sets a positive tone for their learning and engagement throughout the day.

2. School Attire

Many Riverlites do not wear their name tags on their school uniforms, which includes shirts, pinafores and PE T-shirts. We would like to remind all that name tags are part of the uniform and should be visible at all times.

You can purchase the name tags by filling in and submitting the name tag form which your child can obtain from the bookshop.

3. Use of Personal Digital Devices during School Hours

In line with guidelines from MOE, students are not allowed to use personal digital devices during school hours including after-school programmes such as CCA or remedial lessons. These personal digital devices include smart watches and mobile phones.

Riverlites who bring such devices to school are to keep them in their school bags at all times. These devices can be retrieved after school hours and may be used only at the designated areas in school. These designated areas include the security post near the front gate, area near the back gate or outside the general office.

4. Updates on After-School Arrangements

We have received feedback from the members of the public that Riverlites can conduct themselves better in public places such as Rivervale Mall, public transport and playgrounds. Please remind your child/ward to maintain proper conduct at all times.
